Remote Meeting Access:

Governor Baker signed into law Chapter 22 of the Acts of 2022 which extends certain statutes enacted due to Covid-19. This statute states that public bodies may continue to hold remote meetings through July 15, 2022. The prior law extended remote meetings until April 1, 2022. Just a reminder that as of July 16th, when this law expires, boards, commissions and committees may no longer hold either fully remote or hybrid remote meetings. **Starting on July 16, 2022 remote participation will no longer be supported.**
