OFFICE OF THE LICENSING AUTHORITY

SECONDHAND (JUNK) LICENSE VIOLATION POLICY

Section 300

- 1) Vote to Schedule Hearing on Alleged License Violation
- 2) Notify the License Holder
- 3) Conduct Hearing (Procedure Attached)
- 4) Close the Hearing and Vote if a Finding of Violation Occurred and Vote Penalty

Recommended Penalties

- a. First Violation - One Day License Suspension
- b. Second Violation - Two-Day Minimum with up to Five-Day License Suspension
- c. Third Violation - License Revocation
- d. The Board of Selectmen may vote to revoke the license at any time, if they deem it appropriate, based on the level or seriousness of the violation per Section 7 of the Secondhand Dealers and Pawnshops Policy.

The Licensing Authority, the Board of Selectmen, in accordance with M.G.L. c. 140, § 54 and further subject to §§ 202 through 205 of General Laws c.140, inclusive, may suspend, revoke or modify any license whenever it has reasonable cause to believe the licensee has violated the law, terms, conditions or regulations pertaining to such license.
