

Where to Recycle Styrofoam in the Blackstone Valley



The following Massachusetts communities can now recycle Styrofoam at **Blackstone Valley Regional Recycling Center:**

Blackstone, Millville, Mendon, Hopedale, Northbridge, Uxbridge, Douglas, Sutton, Holliston, Medway, and Bellingham.

Hours: Tues., Thurs., Sat. — 9 a.m. to 3 p.m.

Accepted products include clean foodservice foam (coffee cups, take-out containers, meat and produce trays, etc.), packing peanuts (if EPS and not biodegradable), foam used for shipping, etc. Not accepted: spongy foam (like #1 fan fingers, etc.). Pack foam in clear bags.

Directions: Take Rt. 146 to exit 3 – to head west on Rt. 16. Go about a 1/4 mile, and take a left where you see the sign for Lenz Corp. A long warehouse building soon appears on your right with many bay doors, and on the far left-hand side of this building there is a small storage cage on the loading dock. Toss foam into the cage.

Note: Foam should be clean, dry and placed into clear plastic bags. Packing peanuts accepted if EPS and not biodegradable. Not accepted: spongy foam.

Foam can be dropped off at any time.
