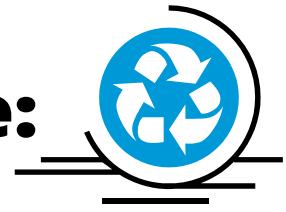


Where to Recycle:



- **Compact Fluorescent Lightbulbs and other Mercury Containing Items:** Examples of items containing mercury are: CFLs, mercury thermometers, thermostats, button batteries and all other batteries. These residential mercury containing items can be dropped off at Auburn Board of Health 104 Central St, Auburn 508-832-7703 during our normal operating hours.
- **Textiles (clothing, linens, stuffed animals, belts, shoes etc.):** You can donate all textiles at collection bins, Salvation Army or other consignment shops. Clothes can be stained or ripped but NOT wet/mildewy or have oil/gas/other hazardous substances on them. More information is available under "Textile Recycling" on the Trash & Recycling home page.
- **Books, CDs, VHS tapes:** Collection bin at Auburn Mall
