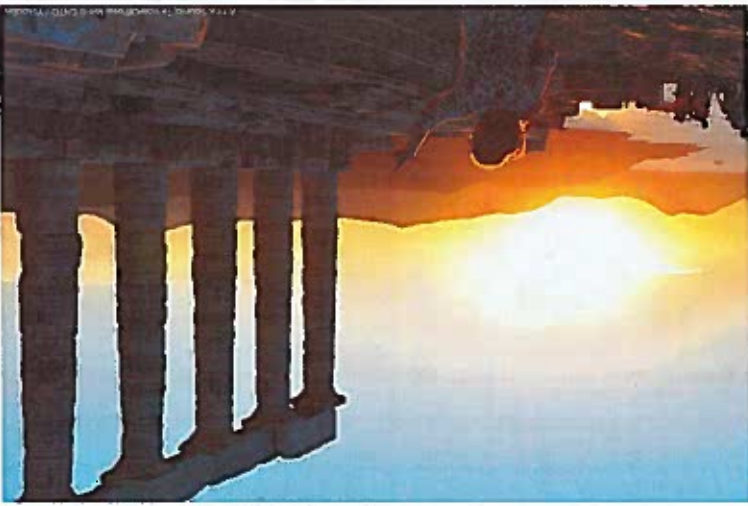
Itinerary:

B = Breakfast, L = Lunch, D = Dinner

Day 1: DEPART USA - Your journey begins with an overnight flight to Greece.

Day 2: ATHENS - Welcome to Athens! A transfer will be waiting for you at the airport to bring you to the hotel. The rest of your day is at leisure to relax or explore this ancient city of myth and legend. Tonight, join your fellow travelers for a welcome dinner. (D)

Day 3: ATHENS - After breakfast, begin a half-day tour of Athens. Visit such sites as the Tomb of the Unknown Soldier, the Royal Palace and the Pan-Athenian Stadium, the Temple of Olympian Zeus and the world-famous Acropolis. Continue on with a drive along the main arteries of the city to view the Academy, the University, the National Library and the Temple of Zeus. This afternoon is free to explore Athens at your own pace. (B, D)



Day 4: CRUISE - This morning, take in some last-minute sightseeing before you set sail on the cerulean waters of the Aegean Sea. In the afternoon, transfer by private coach to Piraeus (port of Athens) and board the Celestyal cruise ship, your home for the next 7 nights. (B, D)

Day 5: MYKONOS - Your first stop is the storied island of Mykonos. Explore this beautiful island at leisure. Spend your day relaxing on the stunning beaches or visit some of its historical treasures, including the archaeological Museum and the Aegean Maritime Museum. (B, L, D)

Day 6: MYKONOS - MILOS - Say goodbye to Mykonos as our ship heads to the island of Milos. Enjoy some free time in the former home of the famous Venus de Milo, indulge in the mouthwatering watermelon pies of Milos or spend your time laying on a beach and soaking up sunshine in the beautiful turquoise waters. (B, L, D)

Day 7: SANTORINI - Welcome to the island of Santorini, perhaps the most breathtaking of all Greek islands. Around 1,500-B.C., a volcanic eruption destroyed the center of the island, leaving a crescent shaped rim of cliffs around a harbor formed in the volcano's caldera. The town of Fira, with its whitewashed houses, narrow streets, open-air cafes and glittering boutiques, clings to these cliffs. To the south is Akrotiri, where recent Minoan excavations support the theories that Santorini might be the fabled lost continent of Atlantis. (B, L, D)



Day 8: SANTORINI - Enjoy another full day in Santorini where villages, vineyards and beaches await. Cruise through the night. (B, L, D)

Day 9: HERAKLION, CRETE - Begin your day with an included excursion to Heraklion, the capitol of Crete. See the ruins of the Palace of Knossos. The elaborate Palace is believed to be the mythical Labyrinth of King Minos and the seat of ancient Minoan culture. (B, L, D)

Day 10: SAMOS - KUSADASI (EPHESUS) - After breakfast you have a choice of either visiting the island of Samos or if you prefer, disembarking in Kusadasi for an included shore excursion. Walking towards the ancient harbor, down a marble road rutted by the wheels of countless chariots, you pass architectural masterpieces like the Magnesia Gate and the Library of Celsus before arriving at the Great Amphitheater. Ephesus should not be missed, for here, history truly comes to life. (B, L, D)

Day 11: ATHENS - USA - Today your journey comes to an end. Say farewell to this enchanting country as you disembark the ship and transfer to Athens airport for your flight home. (B)
