

Friendly Reminders Regarding Trash & Recycling Collection

- While collection times may vary, **all carts must be placed curbside by 7 am** on your collection day.
- Carts must be placed **at least five feet apart** from each other to allow the truck's mechanical arm to function properly.
- All trash must fit in your cart with the **lid completely closed**.
- Trash that does not fit in the cart with the lid closed must be placed in a Town approved **blue overflow bag**. These bags are available for purchase at the following locations:
 - Shaw's-368 Southbridge St, Auburn, MA
 - Park 'n Shop-711 Southbridge St, Auburn, MA
 - Price Chopper-564 SW Cutoff, Worcester, MA
- All trash must be bagged. No loose items are allowed in your trash cart.
- All recycling must be placed loose in your cart. Plastic bags of any kind are not allowed in your recycling cart.
- Recyclable items cannot be placed in your trash cart, and trash cannot be placed in your recycling cart. Use the **Recycle Smart Recycling Guide** on the reverse side for reference.
- Please remember to **flatten and cut cardboard into 2'x2' pieces**. Cardboard that has not been broken down can get stuck in your cart and cause items to be left behind after collection.
- Large or bulky items such as furniture, appliances, carpet, electronics, wood, scrap metal, etc. are not allowed in your trash or recycling carts and require a special pick up. **Please call Casella at 888-532-2735 to schedule a bulk pick up.**
- Solid waste and/or recycling in violation of the Town's regulations will **NOT** be collected. Corrections must be made for the next scheduled pick up day.
